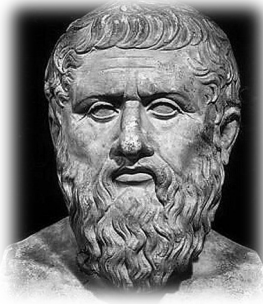


## **Fantasy and Philosophy from Plato to Disney: Writing Outstanding Analysis Essays**

**25–29 July. Online only, 10:00–11.30am & 1:00–3:30pm**



This camp is modelled on the essay-writing intensive classes taken by Arts & Science undergraduate students at Yale and the University of Chicago. These courses show students how to tackle writing across a range of subject areas by breaking essays down into their fundamental elements, and showing how an essay on any topic is built.

We jump right into the deep end here with Plato and Shakespeare – and Disney! Students will learn that the classics are no harder to analyse well than a fairy-tale cartoon. They will take control of the core elements of building an essay from introduction to evidence to analysis; and they will practice critiquing the analysis essays of others, from Ursula Le Guin to their fellow students – and themselves. The skills we teach are those needed to excel as college essay writers – and are ideal practice for IB and A-levels papers and exams, which reward students who are able to apply serious philosophical ideas to a wide range of texts and artistic works using great analytic prose.

### **Schedule and Cost**

Monday to Friday, 25–29 July. Each day features two sessions 10:00–11.30am & 1:00–3:30pm, entirely on Zoom, with daily writing assignments and feedback from instructors.

Tuition is HK\$4,500 per student for the 5-day virtual camp. Discounted ‘siblings and friends’ rate of HK\$4,000 per student for groups of 2+ participants.
