



## Shakespeare!

### Writing Outstanding Analysis of Shakespeare's Plays and Poetry

11–15 July 2022, 9:30am–12pm

Shakespeare can be the most anxiety-inducing part of the English curriculum. This course brings *Othello*, *The Tempest* and Shakespeare's sonnets down to earth! Students will learn to recognise, describe and analyse the themes, ideas, style and language of Shakespeare's works. Shakespeare is a prescribed author across the English curricula, whether students are sitting OIB, A-levels or IB. *Othello* will be an option for AS and A-level English exams and IB exams in the coming years.

By watching, reading and talking about classic scenes together, we will master Shakespeare's subtle use of language, and all the technical details of his lines. Over the course of a week, we will build an essay together that applies serious critical ideas to Shakespeare's works, with our focus firmly on practical skills (and a few tricks) that make serious analysis and sophisticated writing feel easy.

#### Location

The camp will be held on campus at the University of Hong Kong.  
(Run Run Shaw Tower, Centennial Campus – HKU MTR exit C)

#### Schedule

Monday to Friday, 11–15 July. 9:30am–12pm.

Each day's camp runs for 3 hours, which includes two short breaks. Each day's activities involves writing, discussion, and a range of active learning exercises.

#### Cost

HK\$6,000 per student for the full 5-day camp.
